

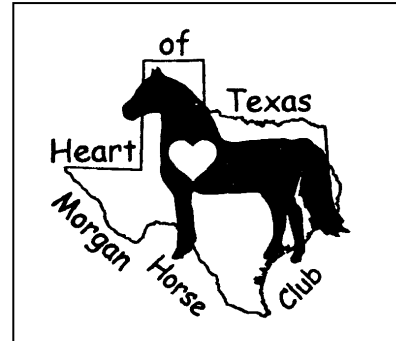

## NEGATIVE COGGINS REQUIRED

- Arena available for practice 2 PM-5 PM, Friday, April 9th
- Entries close 30 minutes before each class
- Classes may be combined or canceled as applicable at option of Show Secretary
- **Maximum 2 Minute Gate Hold**
- Ribbons for placings 1 through 6, including a 1<sup>st</sup> place award
- 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> from each Morgan In Hand class judged for Grand and Reserve Grand Champion Morgan In Hand
- Bits are highly recommended for stallions showing in the in-hand classes
- Adult indicates 18 and over - Youth indicates 17 and under - **HELMETS ARE REQUIRED ON ALL YOUTH**
- Show attire and tack optional - shoes appropriate for riding are highly recommended at all times
- Stallions must be shown by exhibitors 18 and over
- **Walk/Trot RIDERS cannot enter canter classes**
- Lead line class must dismount at out gate
- All dogs must be on leash
- No horses or persons in staging area unless in next class
- No unauthorized personnel in announcer's booth
- Veterinarian on call – Farrier on site
